### MAPLE, RED SUNSET (ACER RUBRUM)

### MAPLE, ROYAL RED (ACER PLATANOIDES 'ROYAL RED')

### OAK, SWAMP WHITE OAK (QUERCUS BICOLOR)

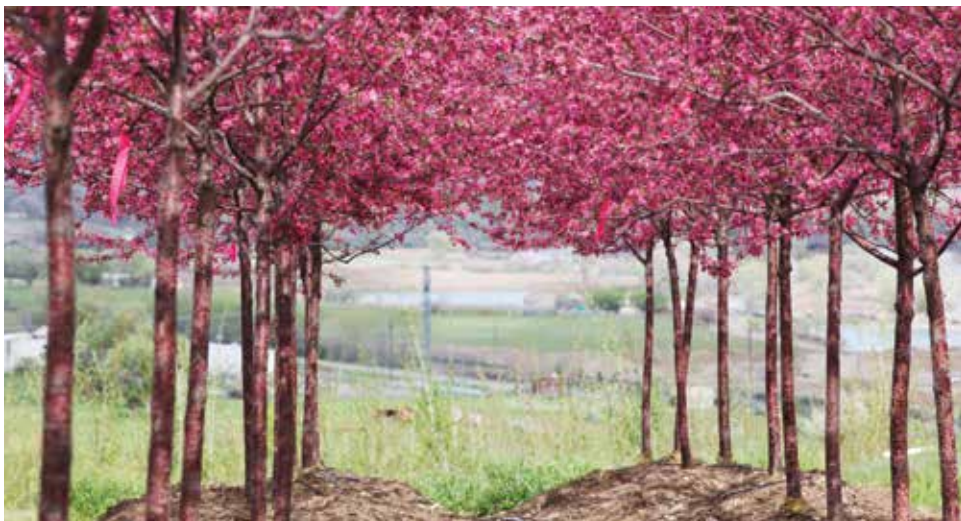
